## **Camping Corfe Castle - (FULLY BOOKED – unable to book on the day)**

If you have booked camping at Norden Park and Ride, Wareham, BH20 5DW (0km) – please read the below about the campsite set up and what you can expect.

### **Arrival at Corfe Castle**

- Check in for our campsite will be open from 3pm – 10pm
- **Campsite closes at 10pm, you cannot arrive later than this**
- If you have booked parking you will receive a separate parking permit via email, you will also be able to pay for parking on the day.
- If you have pre-paid and booked for dinner on Friday night it will be served between 6pm - 9pm in the event start arena.
- **PLEASE NOTE THERE WILL BE NO BOOKINGS FOR FRIDAY DINNER ON THE DAY.** Please show your confirmation email to show proof of purchase
- Early registration will be open from 4pm - 8pm on Friday
- If you are camping - pitch only on Friday night - a reminder to take down your tent on Saturday morning, and if you wish this can be transferred to the Weymouth campsite.
- The campsite will not open until 3.00 pm on Friday – so DO NOT arrive prior to that
- For weekend parking and/or drop off you will be directed to the (Norden Park & Ride, Corfe Castle, Dorset BH20 5DW)
- When you arrive at the campsite at Corfe, please head to the Info Point where you will be directed to the campsite Check-in Area.

### **Camping package**

- If you have booked a full camping package you will be allocated a tent with a roll mat
- A reminder to not forget to bring your own sleeping bag & pillow
- 'Pitch only' – is just that! And there will be an allocated area.
- Please note if you have not pre-booked a dinner, food will not be available for you and we advise that you seek dinner elsewhere (there are pubs in Corfe Castle).
- There is a shower block so bring a towel and flip flops
- You will get a breakfast 'ticket' for the Saturday morning

## **Saturday Morning**

- If you are a pitch-only tent please take your tent down before you head to the start line.
- If you have used one of our tents – please remove all your rubbish & clean up any ‘spillages’ or similar – and roll up the mat please – and leave the tent with the main door zipped up.
- The showers will be open at the campsite so bring a towel and flip flops
- Breakfast will be served inside the main start area from 6am

## **Baggage Transfers**

- Baggage transfers will be available to Bridport or /and Weymouth
- On Saturday morning head to the baggage area. We have ‘sacks’ if you have a few items (ask for one – and say you were camping)
- Baggage is paid for on the day either via card or cash between approx. £5-£15 (depending on the option you choose).

## **Campsite Rules**

- Please be respectful and quiet (other tents are close – and sound travels!)
- We ask that there is zero noise between 10:30pm and 05:00am
- Please do not litter and remove all your rubbish into our bins
- Do not leave any valuables in your tent
- Please limit showers to a couple of minutes
- Please leave the toilets clean after use

## **Weather**

- The weekend is expected to be dry and warm, but will become cooler in the evening, so extras layers for the evening are recommended

## **Arrival at the main Start Venue (Corfe Castle - Full 2 day campers)**

- If you are leaving your car here (and have booked parking) you will receive a separate parking ticket via e mail (parking is close to the main start venue).

- Arrive no earlier than 1 hour before your start time for registration. Once registered please head to baggage area for any bags / tents you would like transferred to Weymouth
- Baggage transfer is not included in the camping package and will need to be paid for on the day (£5-£15 depending on size and final destination – i.e. Weymouth or Bridport)

### **Arrival at Weymouth**

- When you arrive at Lodmoor Country Park venue (whether on foot – or via transport if you are taking on the 2nd Half Challenge on Sunday) - please head to the Info Point where you will be directed to the campsite area at Weymouth College (5 minute walk from Lodmoor Country Park) – any luggage you dispatched via the Baggage Service will need picking up before you head over to the campsite.
- If you are 'pitch only' camping you will be instructed to park in the Beach Car Park – please follow signage – which is a 5 minute walk to the campsite.

### **Camping package**

- If you have booked a full camping package you will be allocated a tent with a roll mat
- A reminder to not forget to bring your own sleeping bag & pillow
- 'Pitch only' – is just that – and there will be an allocated area.
- There is a shower block (and some extra toilets) in the adjacent college building.
- You will get a breakfast 'ticket' for the Sunday morning

### **Sunday Morning**

- If you are a pitch-only tent please take your tent down by 6am before you head to the start line. Your tent can not be left, it must be taken down before you head to the start.
- If you have used one of our tents – please remove all your rubbish & clean up any 'spillages' or similar – and roll up the mat please – and leave the tent with the main door zipped up.
- Take all your baggage to the campsite info point – if you are continuing your challenge on to Bridport.
- Baggage transfers will be available to Bridport (and will need paying for if you are joining at Weymouth)
- Breakfast will be served inside the main start area from 5.00am to 6.00am
- Participants must start the 2nd half between 6.00-7.00am

- Please Note - If you choose to not take part in the second half of your challenge please let us know by 7am on Sunday morning

### **Campsite Rules**

- Please be respectful and quiet (other tents are close – and sound travels!)
- We ask that there is zero noise between 10:30pm and 05:00am
- Please do not litter and remove all your rubbish into our bins
- Do not leave any valuables in your tent
- Please limit showers to a couple of minutes
- Please leave the toilets clean after use

### **Weather**

#### **Bridport to Weymouth**

The pick-up point will be Asker Meadow Sea Road South, Bridport, DT6 4DL (please note the post code will not take you to the correct location), please keep an eye out for event signage and our marshals.

The transfers will be running from Bridport to Weymouth Sunday 5am.

If you have not previously booked car parking at Bridport you will be able to book on the day, £5 per car.

The journey to Weymouth is approx. 45 minutes. Please arrive **15 minutes** before the coach leaves.

#### **Bridport to Corfe Castle**

The pick-up point will be Asker Meadow Sea Road South, Bridport, DT6 4DL (please note the post code will not take you to the correct location), please keep an eye out for event signage and our marshals.

The transfers will be running from Bridport to Corfe Castle Friday 4pm and Saturday 6am.

If you have not previously booked car parking at Bridport you will be able to book on the day, £5 per car.

The journey to the Corfe Castle is approx. 1 hour. Please arrive 15 minutes before the coach leaves. The first transfer that will be running, will be leaving at 5.30am, once this shuttle is full another transfer will be leaving at 6.00am.

## **Wareham Station to Corfe Castle**

The pick-up point will be Wareham train station car park (BH20 4AS). Please look out for a member of the Action Challenge staff in the car park.

The shuttle will be running every 20 minutes to the start line at Corfe Castle so if you are early or late you will be able to jump on the next available shuttle. The shuttles will be available between:

- 3pm – 9pm on Friday afternoon

## **Weymouth to Corfe Castle**

The pick-up will be from Lodmoor Country Park, P&D Car Park (close to entrance, right of Brewers Fayre). If you have paid for parking at the Beach Car Park, the coach departure point is 5 minute walk.

The transfers will be running from Weymouth to Corfe Saturday 6am & 7am.

## **Bridport to Corfe Castle**

Visit our info point on site at Bridport and you will be directed to the pick up point.

**PLEASE NOTE:** We advise that you head to the Info Point before settling down to eat etc. and not leaving it until you wish to leave as there could then be some waiting time before the next departure.

This service will be running regularly, but there may be a wait of up to 3 hours for this service during the quiet times of Sat 17:00 – Sun 07:00, but approx. up to 2 hours wait outside of these hours. The final departure will be Sunday 22:00.

### **Bridport to Crewkerne train station**

Visit our info point on site at Bridport and you will be directed to the pick up point.

**PLEASE NOTE:** We advise that you head to the Info Point before settling down to eat etc. and not leaving it until you wish to leave as there could then be some waiting time before the next departure.

This service will be running regularly, but there may be a wait of up to 3 hours for this service during the quiet times of Sat 17:00 – Sun 07:00, but approx. up to 2 hours outside of these hours. The final departure will be Sunday 21:00.

### **Bridport to Weymouth**

Visit our info point on site at Bridport and you will be directed to the pick up point.

**PLEASE NOTE:** We advise that you head to the Info Point before settling down to eat etc. and not leaving it until you wish to leave as there could then be some waiting time before the next departure.

This service will be running regularly, but there may be a wait of up to 3 hours for this service during the quiet times of Sat 7:00 – 21.00, but approx. up to 2 hours outside of these hours. The final departure will be Sunday 22:00.

### **Church Knowle to Corfe Castle**

Visit our info point on site at Church Knowle and you will be directed to the pickup point.

**PLEASE NOTE:** We advise that you head to the Info Point before settling down to eat etc. and not leaving it until you wish to leave as there could then be some waiting time before the next departure.

This service will be running regularly, but there may be a wait of up to 30 minutes for this service. The final departure will be Saturday 19:00.

### **Lulworth Finish to Corfe Castle**

**PLEASE NOTE:** We advise that you head to the Info Point before settling down to eat etc. and not leaving it until you wish to leave as there could then be some waiting time before the next departure.

This service will be running regularly, but there may be a wait of up to 1 hour for this service. The final departure will be Sunday 23.00.

### **Weymouth to Corfe Castle**

**PLEASE NOTE:** We advise that you head to the Info Point before settling down to eat etc. and not leaving it until you wish to leave as there could then be some waiting time before the next departure.
