Full Camping, Pitch only & Camper Van package bookings

- If you have booked a full camping package you will be allocated a tent with a roll mat once you have signed in, you must bring all other equipment - as we will **NOT** be providing pillows or sleeping bags
- If you are pitch only or camper van you bring all your own equipment etc - and there will be an allocated area
- There is a shower block & toilets at the the campsite for all campers - please bring a towel and flips flops
- All campers will be given a breakfast 'ticket' for the days booked

Friday arrival at Kendal

- Check in for our campsite will be open from 4pm - 10pm
- If arriving later please call or SMS - 07398 948 659
- If you have booked parking please see above for address and access times
- You will be given a parking ticket to display on your dashboard when you check in for camping
- If you have booked for dinner on Friday night it will be served between 18.00 - 21.00 at the Kendal RFU, next to the campsite. **PLEASE NOTE THERE WILL BE NO BOOKINGS FOR FRIDAY DINNER ON THE DAY.** You will be given a dinner voucher at check in
- Early registration & merchandise will be open from 4pm - 8pm on Friday, over in the main event site, a 5 minute walk away from the campsite and head over once your tent is sorted

For Friday night campers - Saturday morning check out

- All 'full package' tents must be cleared out
- If you are booked as a pitch only - a reminder to take down your tent on Saturday morning,
- The showers will be open at the campsite
- Breakfast will be will be served at the main event start area from 6am
- Bags can also be stored at our baggage drop, ready for your return, or transferred to the half way (Lakeside)

Saturday arrival back at Kendal (after your challenge)

- Head to baggage to collect any bags that you may have stored or transferred
- Once you have some food, head to the info point where you will be directed to the campsite
- If you have booked Friday & Saturday night camping package, you would have been allocated same tent for all both nights. Do not leave any valuables in the tents, anything left is at your own risk.
- Breakfast will be served inside the main start area from 5am – 6.15am
- If you are a pitch-only tent please take your tent down by 10am
- If using our tent - please remove all belongings & all rubbish before 10am.

Campsite Rules

- Please be respectful and quiet (other tents are close – and sound travels!)
- We ask that there is zero noise between 10:30pm and 05:00am
- Please do not litter and remove all your rubbish into our bins
- Do not leave any valuables in your tent
- Please limit showers to a couple of minutes
- Please leave the toilets clean after use
- Please no fires/bonfires/BBQ's (anything that is combustible).

Accommodation YMCA - (FULLY BOOKED – unable to book on the day)

If you have booked accommodation YMCA South Camp – Lakeside (50km) - we would like to give you a bit more information about the set up and what you can expect.

When you arrive at YMCA South Camp - please head to the Info Point where you will be directed to the YMCA Accommodation and given breakfast 'ticket' for the Sunday morning – and any luggage you dispatched via the Baggage Service will be at the accommodation.

Facilities

- All rooms have en-suites, showers and a bathroom
- Towels and linen is provided, however beds will be unmade - you will need to make your bed
- You may wish to bring your own sleeping equipment eg sleeping bag, pillow
- If you would like to bring your own sleeping equipment this can be transferred from the start for £15

Checking in to your room

- Once you are ready head to the YMCA to check in and our team will be there to help you
- If you've booked a private room, you will be allocated a room at check in
- If you've booked a dorm only - beds will be allocated upon arrival, teams will need to check in together if you wish to share a room
- Please be considerate of others when in the accommodation

Checking out on Sunday

- Sunday morning we will be doing a wakeup call at 5am
- There will be a rolling start from 6.00 - 6.30am.
- Breakfast will be served inside the main start area from 5.00 - 6.00am.

You will be allowed access to the YMCA accommodation from 2pm on Saturday.

Camping Lakeside (pitch only) - (FULLY BOOKED – unable to book on the day)

If you have booked halfway campsite at YMCA South Camp – Lakeside (50km) - we would like to give you a bit more information about the campsite set up and what you can expect.

Arrival at Lakeside (50km)

- When you arrive at YMCA South Camp - please head to the Info Point where you will be directed to the campsite area – any luggage you dispatched via our Baggage Service will need picking up

Camping

- 'Pitch only' – is just that – and there will be an allocated area
- There is a shower block (and some extra toilets) at the campsite
- You will get a breakfast 'ticket' for the Sunday morning

- A reminder to bring your own tents and sleeping equipment – We will not be providing sleeping bags or equipment
- If you would like to use the showers a reminder to bring towels and flip flops.

Sunday Morning

- If you are a pitch-only tent please take your tent down by 6am before you head to the start line for your start
- Registration will be open from 5.00am
- There will be a rolling start from 6.00 - 6.30am
- Breakfast will be served inside the main start area from 5.00am

Campsite Rules

- Please be respectful and quiet (other tents are close – and sound travels!)
- We ask that there is zero noise between 10:30pm and 05:00am
- Please do not litter and remove all your rubbish into our bins

Post Event Transfers - (Now only available for purchase on the day for £10 – cash/card)

Kendal basecamp to Kendal train Station

Please take your email as confirmation on the day. You and your fellow passengers (if booked more than one seat) must quote your name when joining the post-event transfer.

When you finish your Challenge, please head to the Info Point (red gazebo) where a member of staff will be able to put you on the list for the next coach and advise you of the departure time.

PLEASE NOTE: We strongly advise that you head to the Info Point before settling down to eat etc. and not leaving it until you wish to leave as there could then be some waiting time before the next departure.

This service will be running regularly from 17:00 up until the last train on Saturday & a regular service on Sunday from 06:00, the final departure will be Sunday 22:00. Although there may be a wait up to an hour during quite times.

Kendal to Lakeside

Please take your email as confirmation on the day. You and your fellow passengers (if booked more than one seat) must quote your name when joining the post-event transfer.

When you finish your Challenge, please head to the Info Point (red gazebo) where a member of staff will be able to put you on the list for the next coach and advise you of the departure time.

PLEASE NOTE: We strongly advise that you head to the Info Point before settling down to eat etc. and not leaving it until you wish to leave as there could then be some waiting time before the next departure.

This service will be running hour on Sunday 12 June, the final departure will be Sunday 22:00.

Lakeside to Kendal
