



## BOOKABLE EXTRAS INFORMATION

The closest tube station is Putney Bridge on the District Line; from there it is a 5 minute walk to the start (look for signs). There is **STRICTLY NO** parking or drop off at the start and also very limited parking / access in the surrounding area, so we strongly recommend you use public transport – as it will all be very congested with restrictions – because Fulham FC are playing Chelsea FC at home (ground is accessed via Bishops Park!)

### **Camping Runnymede Saturday Night - (FULLY BOOKED – unable to book on the day)**

As you have booked camping at Runnymede Pleasure Ground, Egham, Surrey, TW20 0AE (50km) - we would like to give you a bit more information about the campsite set up and what you can expect.

#### **Saturday arrival at Runnymede (50km)**

- When you arrive at Runnymede rest stop - please head to the Info Point where you will be put on the next shuttle, which will be running every half an hour and will be a 10 minute journey to the campsite area – and any bags/tents you had transferred from the start will need picking up from the baggage area
- Before heading to the campsite area please have some food when finishing your 50km challenge.

#### **Sunday Morning**

- Breakfast will be served inside the main start area from 5.00am - 6.00am
- A reminder that you will need to get a shuttle back to the start line, which will be running every 20 minutes from 5am and a 10 minute journey
- If you are a pitch-only tent please take your tent down by 6am before you head to the start line for your start.
- If using our tent - please remove all belongings & all rubbish before heading to the start

- If you want your bags moved to your finish (Henley) - there will be a baggage drop
- Registration will be open from 5.00am (2nd Half & 3rd Quarter Challengers need to register)
- There will be a rolling start from 6.00 - 6.30am (for 2 Day, 2nd Half & 3rd Quarter Challengers)
- If you aren't starting Day 2, the only return coach leaves at 8.00am, this coach will go to both Staines Station and Henley finish line. Please head to the information point where you will be directed to the coach.

### **'Pitch only' bookings**

- You bring your own Tent and any other equipment you may need - there will be an allocated area
- A shower block and toilets are provide at the campsite, if you would like to use the showers a reminder to bring towels and flip flops
- You will get a breakfast 'ticket' for the Sunday morning

### **'Full camping' package bookings**

- If you have booked a full camping package you will be allocated a tent with a roll mat
- A reminder to not forget to bring your own sleeping bag & pillow
- There is a shower block in the campsite - please bring a towel and flips flops
- You will get a breakfast 'ticket' for the Sunday morning

### **Campsite Rules**

- Please be respectful and quiet (other tents are close – and sound travels!)
- We ask that there is zero noise between 10:30pm and 05:00am
- Please do not litter and remove all your rubbish into our bin
- Do not leave any valuables in your tent
- Please limit showers to a couple of minutes
- Please leave the toilets clean after use
- Please no fires/bonfires/BBQ's (anything that is combustible)

### **Weather**

- The weekend is expected to be overcast with some rain showers but sunny intervals with highs of 21 C. The temperature will drop down to 16 C in the evening so please bring some warm clothes.

A reminder that the campsite will be open from 12 midday on Saturday, only and will be shut at 7am on Sunday morning.
