Event Day Roles

Everyone will benefit from flexible shifts (4-12 hours), scheduled breaks, and support from a team manager. Roles will be allocated based on interest and preference.

Roles Available

Registration / Bag Drop

Welcome participants as they arrive, complete check in & issue event packs, and answer questions. This role is all about creating a friendly first impression and creating a smooth start.

Parking

Help direct vehicles safely into designated parking areas, keeping traffic flowing and ensuring participants and spectators arrive safely.

Route Marshals

Positioned along the course to guide and encourage participants, provide directions, and communicate with the event team if any support is needed.

Rest Stops

Support participants as they take a break. Help manage refreshments, keep the area tidy, offer encouragement, & watch for anyone who may need assistance.

Cheer Squad

Located at key points and finish lines to motivate participants, hand out medals, and create an uplifting atmosphere. This is all about celebrating the Challengers.

Drivers

Assist with event operations by transporting participants as needed throughout the event and providing support with additional tasks as required.

What's Included

Camping and parking for the weekend (tent and roll matt provided).

Hot meal, food & drink, and pre-event Friday night dinner.

Credits

As a crew member you will earn 10 credits per hour crewed - a 10 hour shift would provide you with 100 credits. These credits are valid for one year, and are redeemable against an Ultra Challenge® event of your choosing.

For example, crewing 10 hours and receiving 100 credits would allow you to enter a 100km Ultra Challenge® for £99.

If you crew on a morning shift, this can be traded to participate in a 10km event that event.

Credits cannot be used against existing sign-ups, they are only applicable to future events.

Credits are managed and logged on our registration platform Active Network. You will receive an email within a week of crewing, confirming your credits and detailing how the scheme works.
